## God's Promises in 1 Samuel

Here are some of the key promises:

Chapter 1:

- God promises to give Hannah a son, who she would dedicate to Him (verse 11)
- God promises to bless Hannah with more children (verse 20)

Chapter 2:

- God promises to exalt those who honor Him (verse 30)
- God promises to cut off the strength of the wicked (verse 9)

Chapter 3:

- God promises to reveal Himself to Samuel and make him a prophet (verse 10)
- God promises to judge the house of Eli for their disobedience (verses 11-14)

Chapter 5:

- God promises to afflict the Philistines with tumors as punishment for taking the ark of the covenant (verses 6-12)

Chapter 6:

- God promises to spare the Israelites from further plagues if they return the ark to Him (verses 3-6)

Chapter 7:

- God promises to save the Israelites from the Philistines if they turn away from their idols and serve Him only (verses 3-4)
- God promises to thunder against the Philistines and confuse them with His power (verse 10)

Chapter 8:

- God warns the Israelites that if they choose a king to rule over them, he will take their sons, daughters, and possessions for his own use (verses 10-18)

Chapter 9:

- There are no direct promises from God in this chapter.

Chapter 10:

- God promises to give Saul three signs to confirm that he will be king over Israel (verses 2-7)
- God promises to change Saul's heart and give him a new spirit (verse 6)

Chapter 11:

- God promises to deliver the Israelites from the Ammonites (verse 9)

- God promises to confirm Saul as the leader of Israel by giving the people a great victory (verse 13)

Chapter 12:

- God reminds the Israelites of all the ways He has blessed and protected them in the past, and promises to continue to do so if they obey Him (verses 6-15)
- God promises to punish the Israelites if they rebel against Him (verse 25)

Chapter 14:

- God promises to help Jonathan and his armor-bearer defeat the Philistines (verse 6)
- God promises to give the Israelites victory over the Philistines (verse 12)

Chapter 15:

- God promises to reject Saul as king because of his disobedience (verse 23)
- God promises to raise up a new king who will be a man after His own heart (verse 28)

Chapter 16:

- God promises to show Samuel who he should anoint as the next king of Israel (verse 3)
- God promises to be with David and bless him as he becomes a great leader (verse 13)

Chapter 17:

- God promises to deliver the Israelites from the Philistines by using David to defeat Goliath (verse 46)

Chapter 18:

- God promises to be with David and make him successful in all his endeavors (verse 12)
- God promises to protect David from Saul's attempts to kill him (verse 17)

Chapter 19:

- God promises to protect David from Saul's attempts to kill him (verse 10)

Chapter 20:

- There are no direct promises from God in this chapter.

Chapter 22:

- God promises to protect David and his followers from Saul's wrath (verse 23)

Chapter 23:

- God promises to deliver the Philistines into David's hand (verse 4)
- God promises to be with David and protect him from Saul (verse 14)

Chapter 25:

- God promises to take vengeance on Nabal and his household for their mistreatment of David and his men (verse 22)
- God promises to make David a lasting dynasty (verse 28)

Chapter 30:

- God promises to give David victory over the Amalekites (verse 8)
- God promises to recover everything that was taken from David and his men (verse 18)
