God's Promises in Nehemiah

1. Promise of Restoration "I will gather them from there and bring them to the place that I have chosen to make my Name dwell there." (Nehemiah 1:9)
2. Promise of Protection "I put it into the heart of the king to extend the favor to me." (Nehemiah 2:8)
3. Promise of Success "The God of heaven will give us success." (Nehemiah 2:20)
4. Promise of Provision "The good hand of my God was upon me." (Nehemiah 2:8)
5. Promise of Strength "Do not grieve, for the joy of the Lord is your strength." (Nehemiah 8:10)
6. Promise of Deliverance "They were all trying to frighten us, thinking, 'Their hands will get too weak for the work, and it will not be completed.' But I prayed, 'Now strengthen my hands.'" (Nehemiah 6:9)
7. Promise of Blessing "If you obey my commands, I will build you up and not tear you down; I will plant you and not uproot you." (Nehemiah 7:5)
8. Promise of Guidance "By day the pillar of cloud did not cease to guide them on their path, nor the pillar of fire by night to shine on the way they were to take." (Nehemiah 9:19)
9. Promise of Forgiveness "But in your great mercy you did not put an end to them or abandon them, for you are a gracious and merciful God." (Nehemiah 9:31)
10. Promise of Renewal "You warned them to return to your law, but they became arrogant and disobeyed your commands. They sinned against your ordinances, of which you said, 'The person who obeys them will live by them.' Stubbornly they turned their backs on you, became stiff-necked and refused to listen. For many years you were patient with them. By your Spirit you warned them through your prophets. Yet they paid no attention, so you gave them into the hands of the neighboring peoples. But in your great mercy you did not put an end to them or abandon them, for you are a gracious and merciful God." (Nehemiah 9:29-31)
11. Promise of Provision "You also gave them bread from heaven for their hunger, and brought water out of the rock for their thirst, and told them to go in to possess the land that you swore to give them." (Nehemiah 9:15)
12. Promise of Protection "In their hunger you gave them bread from heaven, and in their thirst you brought them water from the rock; you told them to go in and take

possession of the land you had sworn with uplifted hand to give them."
(Nehemiah 9:15)
